Supervision of students and postdoctoral fellows

12 PhD (6 ongoing), 7 postdocs (4 ongoing), 27 MSc students (5 ongoing) and 23 BSc students (2 ongoing) as main supervisor since 2006 and 5 PhD students abroad as co-supervisor (1 ongoing). All PhDs have managed to secure subsequent post-doctoral funding abroad. Two of the graduated PhD students have received prestigious Sapere Aude Young Elite Researcher awards from the Danish Research Council in 2011, and one of current post docs achieved the same in 2013.
